

Guidelines

- Minimum crossbar spread: 24" (61 cm), Maximum crossbar spread: 37" (94cm)
- Bicycle weight limit: 40 lbs. (18 kg)
- •2 bicycle maximum on factory crossbars
- •20" 29" wheels only. Fits up to 5" tires
- Remove front fenders, front racks, and panniers before use
- Install as roof rack only
- No electric bikes, kick bikes, recumbents, mopeds, scooters, pannifarthings, tandems, or bikes with 48" (122cm), wheelbase or greater.
- Not for use on trailers or towed vehicles

Parts Included

A: Load Arm Assembly

B: Rear Tray

C: Rear mounting plate

D: Front mounting bracket

E: End Cap

F: Back Stop

G: Wheel Strap


H: Wheel Strap Extension

I: 5mm Hex Key

J: 4mm Hex Key

K: M5x10 Bolt

Note: Rack is configured for installation on the driver's side. For passenger side installation, you will need to remove the arm assembly and reverse, follow steps at "Passenger Side Configuration".






Assembly Instructions


Install Rear Tray

Push on two tabs and remove cover. Slide rear tray onto load arm assembly. Tighten two M6 bolts




Open Mounting Brackets


Remove four M6x65 bolts on front mounting brackets. Slide rear mounting plate into T-slot with brackets facing towards vehicle. Loosen two M6x55 bolts



Tighten Mounting Brackets


Place head onto front crossbar. Slide rear mounting plate above rear crossbar. Tighten six bolts on brackets






Install Wheel Straps

Slide wheel straps onto wheel tray with buckles facing away from vehicle. Install end caps



Install Back Stop


Install cover. Install back stop and tighten two M5x10



Start here: Loading Bikes

Loading Preparation


Fully extend load arm hook. Fully open back stop. Loop wheel straps back and catch on plastic tabs




Loading Bikes

2 Place Bike on Rack


Load bike on wheel tray. FRONT WHEEL SHOULD BE SECURE AGAINST BACK STOP






4 Tighten Wheel Straps

For both wheels: feed wheel strap through wheel and into buckle. Test bike by shaking



5 Fat Bike Installation


To mount fat bikes, add an extension to each wheel strap. For both wheels: feed wheel strap through wheel and into buckle. Test bike by shaking



Start Here: Lock Core Installation Instructions


7 Pry Off Lock Cap


Pry off plastic cap on cover using a screwdriver



2 Install Lock Core

Insert key into core and line up large protruding metal wafer between tabs in housing. Install lock cores, turn key to "lock" position and pull key out







Passenger Side Installation Instructions

Remove End Cap


Remove cover on load arm assembly. Remove M6x15 bolt and plastic stopper. Remove end cap on load arm






Flip Load Arm

Flip load arm and reinstall from the other direction.





Follow Step 1 to Step 5 on Page 1 to mount rack onto vehicle

Warnings
